TERROIR

The Commanderie de Saint Pierre la Garrigue is located on the top of the Saint Pierre la mer hills, seing the Pyrénées mountains and the Mediterranean sea. The vineyard is a former Commanderie of Saint Jean de Jérusalem created a the end of XIIth century. The vines are planted on limestone soils with a presence of medium stones. They are conducted in cordon of royat or cup for the oldest vines. Yields are around 30hl/ha to achieve a fine aromatic intensity and full maturity.

WINEMAKING & BLEND

Grapes are harvested at optimum after casting of each parcells. The alcoholic fermentation is made in ciment tanks to keep the temperature around 26°C with a maceration of 2 to 3 weeks.

The wines are put in barrels (228l) and aged during 8 months.

We blended our best vines of Grenache Noir and Syrah for this vintage.

TASTING

Wonderful brick red color. The nose is intense with some notes of spices and scrubland flowers.

The mouth is full of pepper, menthol with very soft tannins.

FOOD AND WINE PAIRING

Drink this great wine with grilled meats or well aged cheeses.

Serve at 16°C
